24-Hour State Child Abuse Hotline:

For complaints regarding possible child abuse or neglect, call the Child Abuse/Neglect Hotline toll free number: **855-444-3911**. Within 72 hours after making the oral report, the mandated reporter shall submit a written report to Centralized Intake for Abuse & Neglect using Form DHS-3200, which can be accessed at: www.michigan.gov/andatedeporter

Availability and Access to the Center's Licensing Notebook:

At any time during normal operating hours, parent's/guardians may request to view the licensing binder kept current and onsite at all times. The binder contains the following information:

1. All licensing inspection and special investigation reports and related corrective action plans for the last 5 years
 - a. Licensing inspection reports, special investigation reports, and corrective action plans from at least the past 3 years are also available on the department's child care licensing website at www.michigan.gov/michildcare.
